PROPOSED BYLAW CHANGE

There is a proposed Minnesota Women of Today Bylaw change that will be voted on at the business meeting at Winter State Convention on January 24th. To be prepared to vote at Convention, we will be discussing the proposed Bylaw change at our January 8th general meeting, and voting. Members who want to vote must be present at the meeting to do so. The votes will be tallied and and a percentage of yes/no votes will be determined. At Convention, we typically have five or six votes to cast on behalf of our chapter. Those votes will be divided for yes/no with the same percentage as our chapter votes. However, a motion will be made at the January 8th meeting for our voting delegation to be uncommitted for purposes of voting at Convention. This allows our voting delegation to be flexible in case there is a change or some new matter arises which affects our position on voting.

The current Bylaw ARTICLE IX. ELECTIONS AND APPOINTMENT OF OFFICERS Section 4 states: No person shall serve on Executive Council in excess of six (6) years excluding any term as Chairman of the Board of Presidential Assistant (effective May 1, 1994).

The proposed Bylaw, presented by the Future Directions Committee, states: No person shall serve on Executive Council in excess of eight (8) years excluding any term as Chairman of the Board of Presidential Assistant


SARAH SUNDINE

Our Google Groups email account has been a great asset to our chapter. And like many great things; sometimes it gets over used. I am going to provide a little refresher on "Google Groups Etiquette".

- Always add chapter members' email addresses into your own address book
- Make sure to add/update new addresses as needed
- Save the Google Group account for Women of Today related business only—Send to individual addresses for non-WT emails
 - If your message is not for the whole chapter, send your email to individual email addresses from your address book



- To reply to a Google Group email—either hit reply and change the address of who you are replying to or hit forward and type in who you are replying to
- If you want, create your own WT Group in your address book for occasions when the Google Group email isn't quite appropriate

We need to be considerate of members that just don't have the time to be sifting through which emails are important and which ones are just chit chat or may not pertain to them at all.

Of course there will always be the occasional 'oops'. In a rush or replying from your phone, it can be easy to miss that a message was sent by Google Groups. But in general, it would be appreciated for everyone to try to remember some of the general 'Google Groups' etiquette. We haven't had a refresher in sometime, so many of us may have forgotten or may never have even been informed. So ... happy emailing!
