

This story takes place in Nazi Germany during World War II. It describes a young girl's relationship with her foster parents, other residents of their neighborhood, and a young Jewish man who hides in their home during the escalation of World War II.

If you have ideas for any other activities relating to The View (such as the F. Scott Fitzgerald Walking Tour) we'd love your input on that too!


