FIRECRACKER CHILI

By: Lana G.

Yields: 8 servings

Ingredients:

- 1# bulk (hot) Italian sausage
- 2# hamburger
- 4 T chili powder
- 1/4 t ground cumin (optional)
- 1 t coriander
- 1/8 t black pepper
- 1 t cayenne pepper
- 4 cloves garlic, minced
- 1 large onion, diced
- 1/2 c green pepper, chopped
- 1 (28 oz) can diced tomatoes (or fire roasted)
- 1 (15 oz) can tomato sauce
- 3/4 t chipotle tabasco
- 2 (14 oz) kidney beans (black beans or Great Northern beans, or other)
- 1 t minced chipotle peppers in adobo sauce (Note: 2 t or more of this was used in the chili cook-off. This is the HOT stuff!)
- 1 T brown sugar
- 1 cup water, or less
- *** May top w/sharp cheddar cheese or Mexican cheese, sour cream, onions, & cilantro.
- 1. Cook sausage & hamburger in large pot until browned & crumbly. Drain grease, season w/chili powder & coriander, black pepper & cayenne pepper. Cook & stir 1 minute until fragrant, then stir in garlic, onion & green pepper. Cook about 4 minutes, until this has softened & is translucent.
- 2. Stir in diced tomatoes, tomato sauce & all other ingredients. Bring to a simmer for 40 minutes.
