

Breaking Free

This is our 3 year Priority Project. I am looking forward to adding some fun things in the newsletter, pertaining to this area! For now here is a bit about what Breaking Free is....

Breaking Free was established in October 1996, by Vednita Carter, Founder and President, as a nonprofit organization serving women involved in systems of abuse, exploitation, and prostitution/sex trafficking. 87,839 pounds of food was distributed this summer, with 230-250 kids being served each week!!! Thanks to all who helped out.
