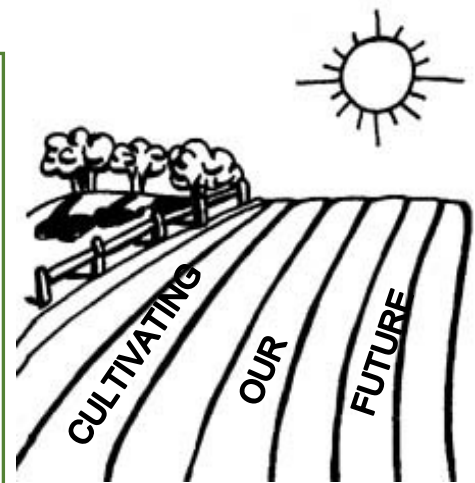

INTERNAL PROGRAMMING

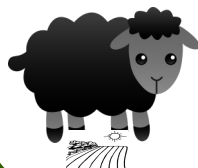

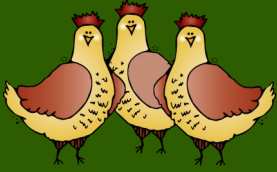
On Saturday, October 29th the Anoka Women of Today hosted a Spooktacular carnival as part of Anoka's Halloween celebration.

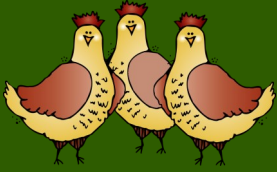
